Gas Price Sensitivity, Senate Seat Event Contracts and Race Consensus Map

At least three states have notable dynamics between event contract price-inferred odds¹, most recent consensus on direction², and the sensitivity of the consumer to the impacts of rising gas prices due to the war with Iran.

Michigan:

- Consensus is a toss up.
- Kalshi contract indicates 80% for Democrat
- The population's vehicle mix indicates a very high sensitivity to gas prices.

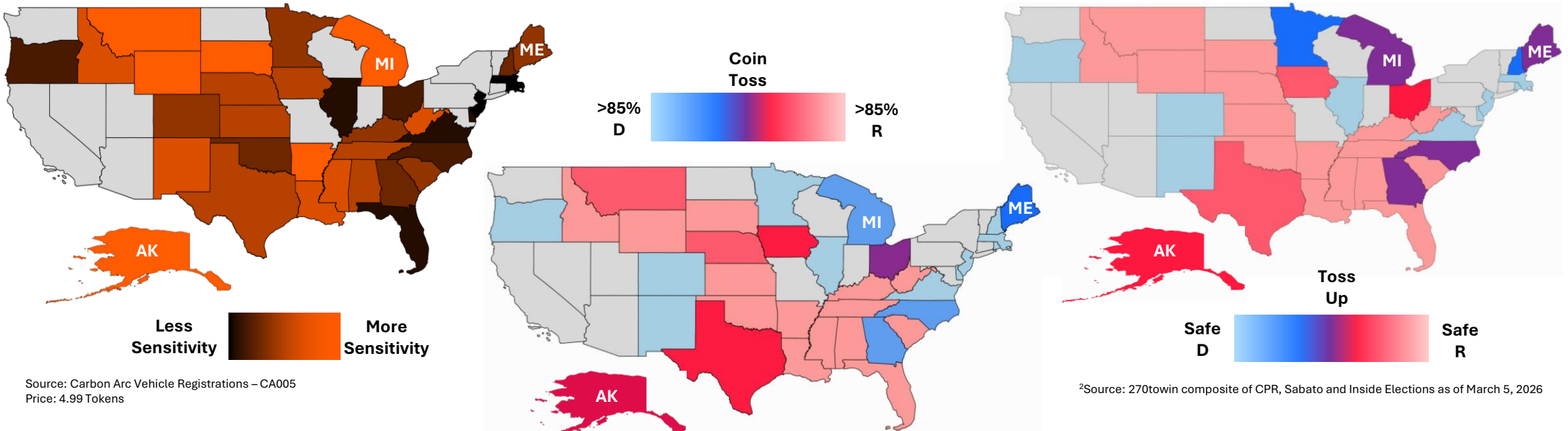
Alaska:

- Consensus is leans Republican.
- Kalshi contract indicates 66% for Republican
- The population's vehicle mix also indicates a very high sensitivity to gas prices.

Maine:

- Consensus is a toss up.
- Kalshi contract indicates 69% for Democrat
- The population's vehicle mix indicates a moderately high sensitivity to gas prices.
